Drop-Off and Pick-Up Expectations

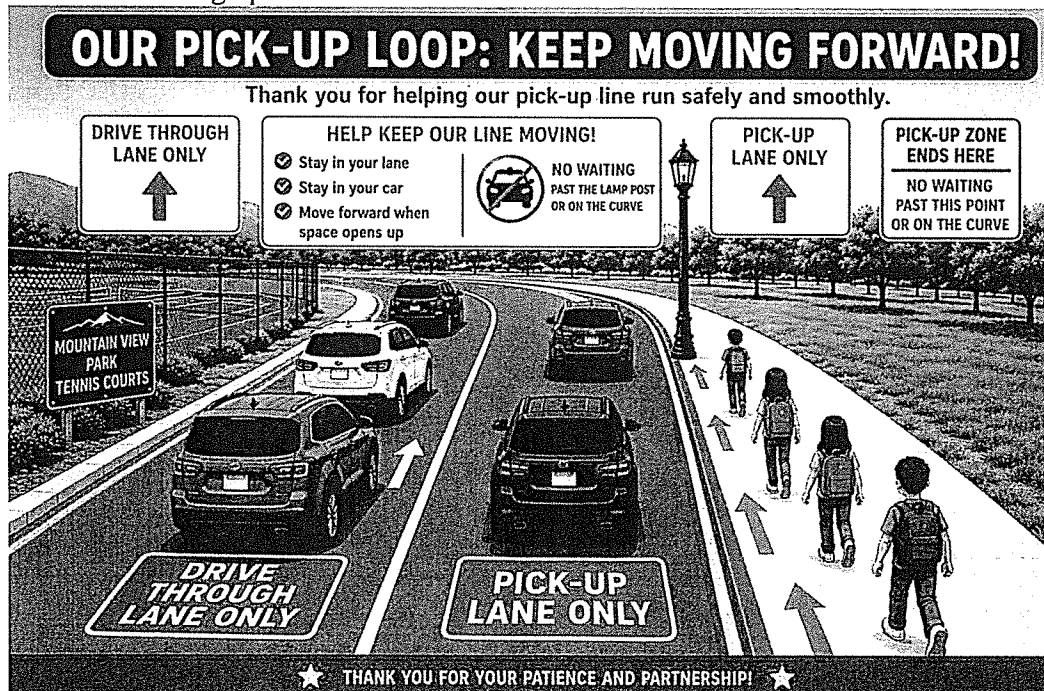
To ensure the safety of everyone:

1. Arrival and Dismissal Times

- Do not arrive for drop-off before **8:45 AM**.
- Do not arrive for pick-up before **3:15 PM**.
- Follow all directions from school staff and crossing guards.

2. Use of Lanes

- Quick drop-offs and pick-ups (**30 seconds or less**) are permitted **only in the RIGHT lane**.
- The **LEFT lane is for through traffic only**. Do not stop there unless directed by school staff or a crossing guard.
